True / False	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Simplest question type, true false answers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Step by step walk through here 	More info
Multiple choice	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students select answers and can allow one or more correct answers <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Step by step walk through here 	More info
Numerical	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Numerical answer with acceptable 'range' and can also add in use of 'units' Step by step walk through here Using the Equations Editor to Insert Mathematical Equations 	More info
Short answer	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students type short answer and will receive marks depending on whether it matches the listed acceptable answers written by the tutor 	More Info
Calculated (simple)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Allows calculated questions which substitute random values into the question's equation Step by step walk through here Other versions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Calculated complex – more in depth control Calculated multiple choice 	More info
Stack	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Third party maths specific plug in Github link 	More Info
Essay	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The only question type not marked automatically. Long form answers 	More Info
Drag and drop into text	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Drag correct text answer(s) into a sentence Other versions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Drag and drop onto marker Drag onto image 	More Info
Missing words	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sentences with drop down selection of words for missing word 	More Info
Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Not assessed, just a way to present extra information to students
